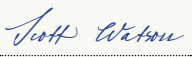


THE LOST DISTILLERY COMPANY

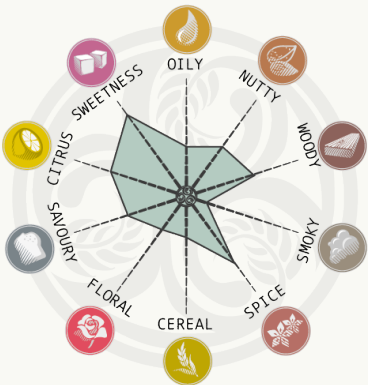
Whisky is a huge part of Scotland’s history and culture. Yet almost half of our distilleries have now closed, to become Lost Distilleries.

Our Archivists and Master of Whisky engage in a balance of science and art to understand how the original Whisky might have tasted and blend modern malts to breath life back into the distillery.

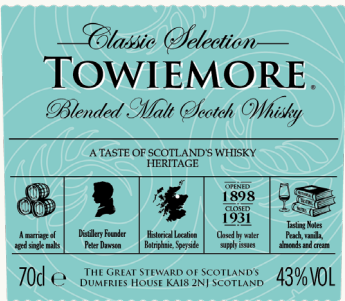
Towimore Distillery began life in 1898 near Dufftown in what is now known as Speyside. Founder Peter Dawson owned a number of distilleries through his life and Towimore was his heart and soul. Towimore was enjoyed by Kings and captured the whisky boom using technology and whisky know-how to become a consistent top ranking pure malt whisky in Scotland. Towimore was sadly Lost in 1931 following competitor sabotage and a global collapse in Scotch Whisky. Until now.
